### **CATEGORIES**

There are several categories in which to enter. Submit an entry in one or all. However, please limit yourself to one entry per category per fabricator.

**The categories are:**

- 1.) Power Boats - Canvas Covers
- 2.) Sailboats - Exterior Canvas
- 3.) Power Boat Enclosures (27' and up)
- 4.) Power Boat Enclosures (26' and under)
- 5.) Power or Sail Interiors
- 6.) Power or Sail Exteriors (Upholstery, Carpet, Etc.)
- 7.) Most Unusual-Marine Related
- 8.) Non-Marine Related
- 9.) Hard Window Enclosures
- 10.) Canvas non-marine

### **PHOTO CONTEST RULES**

- 1.) Only convention attendees may enter.
- 2.) Each firm may enter any and all categories, but with only one entry per category.
- 3.) Color prints up to 5" x 7" may be entered. PRINT YOUR COMPANY NAME ON THE BACK ONLY. Up to 3 shots per entry are allowed. Sorry, no slides can be accepted.
- 4.) All entries must be of projects completed after January 1, 2011 and have not previously been entered in a CMCFA photo contest.
- 5.) Photos to be entered must be brought to the registration table between 9:00am Thursday, February 16<sup>th</sup>, and 9:30am Friday morning, February 17<sup>th</sup>. You can pick up your photos during Market Day on Saturday, February 18<sup>th</sup>. We encourage you to get them in as early as possible.
- 6.) Each entry will require a completed entry form at the time the entry is submitted.
